



OUR STORY SO FAR

The Waitara Taiohi Trust continues to stand as a source of hope and connection for the taiohi of Waitara. Now in its fourth year, the Trust has grown into a trusted presence in our community, grounded in the values of belonging, identity, and rangatiratanga. Our vision remains: to see every taiohi woven, whole, and winning.

Over the past year, we've expanded our reach to run 14 core programmes, along with a growing social enterprise, Manaaki Coffee. Each programme is designed to meet the real needs of taiohi, providing pathways into leadership, belonging, employment, skills and wellness. Whether it's through mentoring at Waitara High School, leading a youth event, or training as a barista in our coffee cart, our taiohi are stepping up, showing mana, and growing in confidence.

Our kaupapa is relational—everything starts with connection. Experienced youth workers walk alongside our young people, building trust and encouraging them to thrive in their identity and future. We've seen strong outcomes across all areas: increased self-worth, better mental health, and more taiohi stepping into qualifications and mahi.

This year, we've focused heavily on creating youth-led spaces. Ten of our eighteen major events were taiohi-led, showing what's possible when young people are given the tools and trust to lead. All our programmes—from Talanoa Taina's for young tane to Dub Academy Basketball, Girls Group, Inspire, and our High School mahi—are shaped by regular taiohi feedback and designed to uplift and reflect their voices.

Looking ahead, our commitment remains clear: to awhi taiohi in building a deep sense of belonging, identity, and confidence. Together with whānau, hapū, kura, and the wider community, we're seeing Waitara's young people rise.

VISION/PURPOSE/ THEORY OF CHANGE

At Waitara Taiohi Trust, everything we do flows from our vision: He puna wai koropupū ko Waitara – a place of refreshing where taiohi are woven, whole and winning. Our purpose is to awhi taiohi in building a deep sense of belonging, identity, and confidence (He pūrengi mātou hei tautoko i ngā pou taiohi).

All our programmes and mahi are grounded in our Theory of Change, which guides us to walk alongside taiohi through mentoring, trusted relationships, life skills, and rangatiratanga (leadership development). Whether it's through weekly youth groups, school-based mentoring, cultural spaces, or real-world training, each initiative supports taiohi on a pathway to thrive.


Our Vision

"When I first met the Waitara Taiohi Trust, I didn't even know who they were until my best friend invited me to youth group on a Wednesday night. Since then, they've helped me grow so much — in my skills, my confidence, and in learning to trust both others and myself. I've been able to get involved in heaps of their programmes, like helping out on the coffee cart, which has taught me new skills and helped me feel more comfortable meeting new people. I used to be shy, but now I'm more confident and proud of who I'm becoming. Just being around the youth workers — seeing how kind and supportive they are — has inspired me. Because of them, I've grown into a stronger, more confident wahine."

"Tewhaia and Nelly have been a huge part of my life. Ever since I met them, they've felt like family to me. They've helped me through my struggles and reminded me that I'm not alone. They're people I can trust and count on when I need support. To me, they're more than just leaders or role models — they're like older brothers who have always been there, even when I didn't ask. They've got the biggest hearts and don't wait around for others to step up. They live out what it means to be a youth worker and show what a real leader looks like."





"Before I found the Waitara Taiohi Trust, I didn't have much guidance or support. I had goals in my head but no clear path or anyone to turn to. At times, I felt stuck and misunderstood. Since being involved with the Trust, everything has changed. They've given me a safe space to grow, learn, and just be myself. Whether it's one-on-one support, group programmes, or just someone to talk to, they've helped me find my confidence and realise my worth. They've shown me that my past doesn't define my future. I've now got people who genuinely care and believe in me—and because of that, I'm in a much better place and excited for what's ahead."

LOYAL LEADERS 2022-10W

Loyal Leaders is a dynamic programme offered by the Waitara Taiohi Trust, empowering young individuals aged 14 to 25 to grow as leaders and make a positive impact in their community. Through a series of engaging activities and structured sessions, participants develop essential life skills, build meaningful relationships and connections, and cultivate leadership qualities rooted in rangatiratanga principles.

The Internship program by the Waitara Taiohi Trust is a transformative journey aimed at creating employment pathways for taiohi (young people) by providing comprehensive professional training as qualified youth workers. Through this program, taiohi gain invaluable practical experience, mentorship, and educational support to kickstart their careers in the field of youth work. Qualifications offered include a Certificate in Youth Work, Diploma in Youth Development, and Bachelor in Youth Development.

INSPIRE 2023 - NOW

The Inspire Program by the Waitara Taiohi Trust is a dynamic initiative designed to ignite passion, creativity, and personal growth among taiohi (young people). Through engaging workshops, mentorship, and community projects, the program aims to inspire taiohi to discover their strengths, pursue their dreams, and make positive contributions to their communities.

This program is run during club time at Waitara High School as well as on weekends. It has already led to four community events, all created and run by taiohi.

Outcomes: Increased access to opportunities, better understanding of who they are and can be, and greater capability to create opportunities for others.

These contracted youth workers provide over 30 hours of on-location support each week, offering essential pastoral care and mentoring. They lead a variety of events and programs throughout the school year, creating opportunities for students to connect, grow, and thrive. Together, Waitara Taiohi Trust and Waitara High School are committed to fostering a positive and nurturing environment that empowers youth to reach their full potential through dedicated service and impactful programs.

TALANOA TAINA'S 2024-10W



Social Enterprise that is Brewing Purpose with Every Cup

- Brewing Purpose with Every Cup Manaaki Coffee is more than just a coffee cart — it's a social enterprise run by taiohi, for taiohi. Through this kaupapa, young people gain hands-on experience in customer service, barista skills, stock management, and small business operations, all while being supported through ongoing training and mentoring.

A huge mihi to the Toi Foundation for funding the purchase of the cart — your support made this dream a reality. We also want to thank Proof and Stock for providing expert training and helping us get set up with the right equipment and supplies. Together, you've helped empower our taiohi with tools, confidence, and real-world skills.

Since launching, Manaaki Coffee has popped up at 11 different markets and community events — and this is just the beginning. We're now actively exploring a permanent space where the cart can operate regularly, giving taiohi even more opportunities to build confidence, develop skills, and serve the community with pride.





"Before I started with Manaaki Coffee, I had no idea how to make coffee or what it was like to actually work with customers. At first, I was nervous, but the team showed me step by step how to do everything. I got to learn real barista skills, including how to take orders and deal with people in a calm and professional manner. Now I actually feel confident talking to people, and I've even applied for part-time jobs. Manaaki gave me the boost I needed — I've got experience now, and I know I can do it."



Across 2024–2025, our programmes engaged over **427** individual taiohi, with **376** attending more than three sessions — showing real consistency and commitment. Through weekly groups, mentoring, events, and leadership spaces, taiohi gave strong feedback across all areas.

Based on more than 320 feedback forms, the following highlights the average outcomes after participating in Waitara Taiohi Trust programs:
